The Future of Us by Jay Asher. FIC ASHER. Set in 1996, long before Facebook is created, two friends discover the site but wonder if this really is a window into their future.

Anna Dressed in Blood by Kendare Blake. FIC BLAKE.

For three years, Cas Lowood has carried on his father's work of dispatching the murderous dead, traveling with his kitchen-witch mother and their spirit-sniffing cat. When he meets Anna, a girl unlike any ghost he has faced before, everything changes.

Bronxwood* by Coe Booth. FIC BOOTH. Tyrell is stressing out because his dad is getting out of jail, his mom is unreliable, and his younger brother is in foster care. Can he change it? Sequel to "Tyrell."

Out of Sight, Out of Time* by Ally Carter. FIC CARTER.

The Gallagher Girls series continues as 17-year-old Cammie wakes up in a convent in the Alps. She slowly comes to realize that she's been tortured, part of her memory has been erased, and a terrorist group is after her.

The Selection* by Kiera Cass. FIC CASS. An American singer is chosen to compete in the Selection (a contest to see which girl can win the heart of Illea's prince). But can she really give up the chance for a future with her secret love, Aspen?

Lovetorn by Kavita Daswani. FIC DASWANI. Having just moved from India to Los Angeles for two years, 16-year-old Shalini struggles to fit in at school and keep things at home in order. Things get even harder when she falls in love with an American boy despite her family's traditions.

Seraphina* by Rachel Hartman. FIC HARTMAN.

Seraphina has a love of music and a dark side that she must hide in this world where, though dragons and humans coexist, tensions abound.

Legend* by Marie Lu. FIC LU.

In a dark future, when North America has split into two warring nations, 15-year-olds Day, a famous criminal, and prodigy June, the brilliant soldier hired to capture him, discover that they have a common enemy.

The Golden Lily* by Richelle Mead. FIC MEAD.

Alchemist Sydney, Moroi princess Jill, and their friends are hiding their identities at a California boarding school for human kids until forbidden romances, unexpected spirit bonds and the encroaching Stringoi threaten to expose them.

All the Right Stuff by Walter Dean Myers. FIC MYERS.

Paul volunteers at a Harlem soup kitchen where he listens to lessons from an elderly African American man and mentors a 17-year-old mother who wants to make it to college on a basketball scholarship.

Insurgent* by Veronica Roth. FIC ROTH. The sequel to "Divergent" finds Tris Prior's initiation day shattered by Erudite simulation attacks that end the lives of several loved ones and launches a bitter war, compelling Tris to embrace her Divergent nature and make painful sacrifices.
