TEACHER CARD

All teachers currently employed at a school in the City of Milwaukee are eligible for a teacher library card. Teacher cards can be used to check out school-related materials from any Milwaukee Public Library. Proof of employment by a school located within the City of Milwaukee is required. Teachers who reside within Milwaukee County are eligible to apply for both a teacher and a personal library card. The teacher card is valid for one school year.
