## **Volunteers Needed**

### **Milwaukee Public Library Needs Adult Tutors**

Adult volunteers are needed to provide one-on-one tutoring for adult learners at the Milwaukee Public Library. The volunteers will provide tutoring for Milwaukee residents ages 18 and older who want to upgrade their basic math and reading skills, and for adults working toward completing their GED or studying English as a second language.

- Mondays, March 2, 9 and 16 - 5:15 to 8:15 p.m.

A **fourth session** is an orientation event that will take place at a neighborhood library chosen by the volunteer tutor on either Monday, February 16 or Monday, March 23. Both sessions run from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.
