- 1. What is the total number of staff and board members at MPL? Approximately 350 when fully staffed and 12 board members.
 - a. Do you envision engaging all staff and board in the initial assessment (survey, focus groups, interviews) phase?
 All staff and the Board should be engaged in the initial assessment.
 - b. Specifically, are you intending to engage all staff and board members in the survey? Yes, the assessment phase and action plan will include all.
- Will you engage the MPL Foundation and/or Friends of MPL in the process? Specifically, do you imagine engaging them in the assessment (survey, focus groups, interviews)?
 Yes, all MPL Foundation staff and Friends of MPL should be engaged in the initial assessment.
- 3. Do you imagine engaging external stakeholders in the first phase assessment (survey, focus groups, interviews)? By external stakeholders, I mean partners, volunteers, etc. Those who can lend perspective as to where you are currently on your REI journey or will be impacted by the strategies developed through this process.
