Help your child join the Super Reader Squad!

The Milwaukee Public Library Summer Reading Program starts June 1. It's fun, free, and easy! Sign up all summer long at your nearest MPL branch or get started online at mpl.beanstack.org. The choice is yours! Children can start reading and tracking on June 1. Make sure to stop by the library so your child can choose a free book to get started reading this summer!

The Super Reader program helps children ages 12 and younger to continue learning during the summer by **READING**—choosing what they want to read, **CREATING**—visiting MPL to participate in a LEVEL UP art activity inspired by Milwaukee public art, and **DISCOVERING**—visiting MPL for a Public Art Scavenger Hunt map to explore Milwaukee neighborhoods and public art!

Reading in summer can make a huge difference when children go back to school in the fall. Children can lose 2-3 months in reading skills if they don't read over the summer. These summer learning losses can add up, leaving some children years behind their peers by the time they reach high school. Join the Super Reader Squad and help children across Milwaukee avoid this loss by reading all summer long.

A library card is NOT required to participate in Super Reader! However, if you want to get one, just stop in and ask about getting a free library card for you or your child.
