


LEVEL UP ART CHALLENGE



Straw Rocket











Step 1 Take the template and use scissors to cut out the shapes. Cut along the solid black lines. Don't forget to cut the line that goes halfway through the circular piece and only to the center point.

Step 2 (Optional) Before any folding and taping, feel free to decorate your pieces.

Step 3 Roll your long rectangular piece into a tube. You can roll it tightly along the straw, but it is **very important** that the paper tube can slide off of the straw. Pull out the straw and then put a piece of tape on the tube.

Step 4 Roll your circular piece into a cone. Use a piece of tape to secure it into place.

Step 5 Roll up a piece of tape and place it on the inside of your cone at the tip. Secure your cone to the top of the tube.

Step 6 Attach the two wing pieces to either side of the paper tube.

Step 7 Time for lift off! Launch your rocket by placing it on the straw and blowing the free end. Take it outside and see how far you can launch your rocket.
