Paper Flower









Step 1 Take your template and trace the 3 shapes onto different pieces of colorful paper.

Step 2 Cut out the shapes you traced in the previous step.

Step 3 (Optional) Color the pieces of paper with markers.

Step 4 Curl the ends of the petal pieces inwards. You can use a marker or pencil to help create the curls.

Create one with tighter curls for the inner piece.

Step 5 Wrap the long spiky piece tightly. You can begin by wrapping the long piece around a pencil. Once it is fully wrapped, tape it into place. It should look like a little crown.

Step 6 Glue your inner petal piece on top of the other petal piece. Add a dot of glue on the flat side of the spiky "crown" piece and place it inside the center of the flower.
