A Pet for Petunia* by Paul Schmid. PIC SCHMID.



Reading Tips

Re-read Again - Even though you may be tired of re-reading your child's favorite book over and over, this activity helps build up their word bank so he or she can more easily recognize those words in other contexts.

Take Some Time - Learning to read isn't a test or a timed activity. Give your child plenty of time to read through the book they chose. Reading the book out loud first, then giving them a chance to go through it themselves can be a great way to build reading skills.
