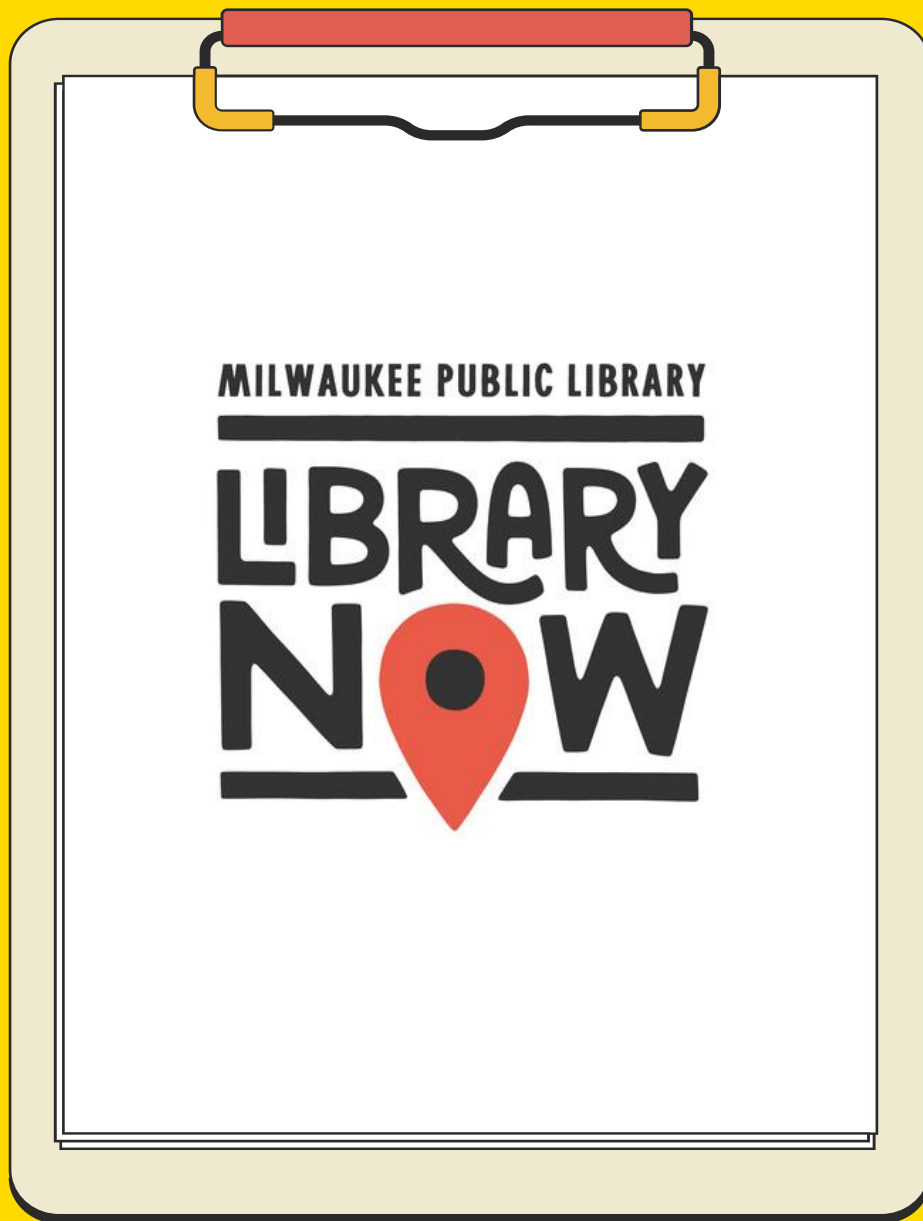


SCAVENGER HUNT TEMPLATES





VERSION 1: KIDS RESOURCE OVERVIEW

Overview for Facilitator:



This scavenger hunt is designed for preliminary exploration of LibraryNow Kids resources (can be adapted to include additional resources for Middle/High School aged students as well). Students can work independently or collaboratively, and there are corresponding correct answers (sometimes more than one).

VERSION 2: PERSONAL EXPLORATION

Overview for Facilitator:



This rendition can be utilized as a “Part Two” to the LibraryNow resource overview scavenger hunt, or as a stand-alone. This prompts students to not only understand what each resource has to offer, but to engage by utilizing features of LibraryNow resources and sharing how it went. There is no right or wrong answer - the student is given the corresponding LibraryNow resource and prompted to share what they enjoyed and discovered.
